



REMOVAL OF STOCK SYSTEM

- 1 Remove the stock exhaust system as described in your owner's manual. (Retain the flange nuts for the new system installation).
- 2 Remove the stock flanges from the head pipes and retain for the new system installation.
- 3 Remove the stock exhaust mount bracket.
- 4 Remove the stock exhaust gaskets and replace them with new conical type exhaust gaskets (Not included.)

SUPERTRAPP X-PIPE INSTALLATION

- 1 Install the new mounting bracket to the stock location using the spacers, washers, lock washers and bolts supplied (SEE FIGURE 1). Tighten to manufacturers specification, see service manual.
- 2 Install the stock flanges on both head pipes.
- 3 Install the new rear head pipe using the stock flange nuts. (DO NOT TIGHTEN).
- 4 Align the pipe with the mounting bracket and install a supplied 5/16 bolt, two 5/16" washers, and one 5/16" nylock nut. (DO NOT TIGHTEN).
- 5 Install the rear heat shield and tighten using the #24 hose clamps supplied.
- 6 Install the new front head pipe using the stock flange nuts. (DO NOT TIGHTEN).
- 7 Align the pipe with the mounting bracket and install a supplied 5/16 bolt, two 5/16" washers, and one 5/16" nylock nut. (DO NOT TIGHTEN).
- 8 Align both pipes so they are parallel to each other and tighten all fasteners starting at the exhaust port and working back to the mounting bracket.
- 9 Install the front heat shields using the #24 hose clamps supplied with the system. Be sure to locate the clamp screw so it can be accessed with a screwdriver or 5/16" socket while on the bike.

*IMPORTANT: AFTER A SHORT RIDE CHECK AND RETIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS.

TUNING TIPS

Temperature, humidity, elevation, engine modifications, etc., all play a role in determining correct jetting. As a rule, any increase in intake and/or exhaust flow will require an increase in fuel.

Proper jetting is best performed by a qualified technician. Call your local dealer for recommendations on jetting changes for your bike.
