

### **STOCK SYSTEM REMOVAL**

- **1.** Remove saddlebags to gain access to muffler mounting bolts.
- 2. Remove inlet clamps bolt and two mounting bolts (each side).
- 3. Remove mufflers.

# **KERKER INSTALLATION**

- **1.** Slide inlet clamps onto muffler inlets. (For pre 1995 models, use stock clamp and seal; for 1995 and later models, use supplied clamp and no seal).
- **2.** End Cap Installation:
  - A. Remove End Cap screws from mufflers.
  - B. Insert End Cap, lining up the screw holes
  - C. Re-install and tighten End Cap screws.
- Install mufflers onto headpipes, line up mounting bracket using supplied 5/16" 18 x 5/8" bolts, lockwashers and square nuts and mount to stock bracket (see Fig. 1).
- 4. Tighten clamps
- 5. Install saddlebags.

NOTE: Turndown End Caps can be rotated to face in three different directions. Choose the look that's best for you.

### **STOCK SYSTEM REMOVAL**

- 1. Remove saddlebags to gain access to muffler mounting bolts.
- **2.** Remove inlet clamps bolt and two mounting bolts (each side).
- **3.** Remove mufflers.

### **KERKER INSTALLATION**

- 1. Slide inlet clamps onto muffler inlets. (For pre 1995 models, use stock clamp and seal; for 1995 and later models, use supplied clamp and no seal).
- 2. End Cap Installation:
  - A. Remove End Cap screws from mufflers.
  - B. Insert End Cap, lining up the screw holes
  - C. Re-install and tighten End Cap screws.
- Install mufflers onto headpipes, line up mounting bracket using supplied 5/16" 18 x 5/8" bolts, lockwashers and square nuts and mount to stock bracket (see Fig. 1).
- 4. Tighten clamps
- 5. Install saddlebags.

NOTE: Turndown End Caps can be rotated to face in three different directions. Choose the look that's best for you.
